Everton Primary School – pollinator project

£3,000 was awarded towards fencing, equipment and planting for a pollinator project in the school's community orchard.

Glentham Parish Council – play area refurbishment

Awarded a grant of £3,000 towards refurbishment of the village play park.

Hallcroft Infant and Nursery School – new community play zone

£2,300 was awarded for the purchase of play equipment and activities for a new play zone for younger children and their families at the heart of the community.

St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, Retford – community mural

Awarded a grant of £2,200 towards a community project to design and create new murals on the walls of the pedestrian tunnel providing access to the school.

Westwoodside Playing Fields Association – new floodlights

£2,000 was awarded for the purchase of more efficient LED floodlights to replace old equipment that was expensive to run and falling into disrepair.

Reepham Parish Council – resurfacing of pathway

Awarded a grant of £2,000 towards the cost of relaying a much-used pathway to the village play area that had become impassable in wet weather.

Mattersey Primary School – new blinds for community hall

£2,000 was awarded for the purchase of new blinds for the hall, enabling it to be used throughout the year for a range of school and community events and activities.

Barnby Moor Parish Council – improvements to village hall toilet facilities

Awarded a grant of £2,000 towards improvements to the toilets at Barnby Moor village hall.

North Notts Artisan & Tourist Information Centre (Retford Hub) – building improvements

£1,000 was awarded to the Retford Hub towards a project to improve the general appearance of the building and the display facilities within it to help promote the work of local artisans.

Blyton Parish Council – junior activity trail

Awarded £1,000 towards the cost of a junior activity trail as part of a new play park project.

St George's Primary School, Gainsborough – woodland extension and improvements

£1,000 was awarded towards a project to extend and develop the school's woodland area as an outdoor learning facility.

RAF Ingham Heritage Group – building renovations

Awarded £1,000 towards the cost of materials to enable a group of volunteers to renovate the main entrance to the RAF Ingham Heritage Centre.

Lincolnshire Rivers Trust – restoration of Nettleham Beck

£1,000 was awarded towards the purchase of plants and trees for a project to improve and prevent the deterioration of the stream through Sudbrooke.

Cherry Willingham Parish Council – picnic tables for community area

Awarded £1,000 towards the purchase of picnic tables for the Cherry Fields community green space.

Finningley and Blaxton Playing Fields Association – new tables and chairs for sports pavilion

£1,000 was awarded to purchase tables and chairs for a new sports pavilion.

Dunholme Old School Community Centre – external renovations

Awarded £1,000 towards the cost of renovating the exterior of this community building.

Kings Worthy Primary School – outdoor eco classroom

An award of £3,000 was made towards a new outdoor classroom to be run on sustainable energy sources.

Goodworth Clatford Parish Council – fencing for new village nature and recreation area

£3,000 was awarded for the fencing of a meadow forming part of a new public open space in the village of Goodworth Clatford, enabling cattle to graze safely and maintain the pasture.

Singleton and Charlton Parish Council – improvements to play area

£2,500 was awarded towards the cost of improvements to the public path and Glebe Field play park.

Binsted Primary School – community seating and planting area

Awarded £2,000 towards the creation of a community seating and planting area where members of the local community can work with pupils at the school to grow and harvest fruit and vegetables.

Clanfield Junior School – equipment for breakfast and after-school club

An award of £1,750 was made to enable the school to purchase equipment and activities for its breakfast and after-school club.

Church Homeless Trust – storage sheds

A grant of £1,250 was awarded to Church Homeless Trust for the purchase of storage sheds for gardening tools and equipment at three housing schemes supporting the homeless in the Guildford area.

KIDS Smile Centre, Waterloo – equipment for music therapy room

£1,000 was awarded towards the purchase of instruments and equipment for a music therapy room for disabled children at the KIDS Smile Centre.

Riverside Community Special School – sensory garden

An award of £1,000 was made towards the cost of planters and seating for a sensory garden at the Riverside Community Special School – a project that is being developed with the help of parents and carers.

Peaslake Village Hall – replacement boiler

£1,000 was awarded towards the cost of a new boiler for the village hall.

Challengers – play equipment for disabled youngsters

An award of £1,000 was made towards the cost of equipment at three play schemes for disabled young people in Hampshire and Surrey.

Bletchingley Village Hall – new boiler

£1,000 was awarded towards the cost of a replacement boiler at Bletchingley Village Hall.
